- 1. What am I referring to when I say we are studying the "Catastrophe"? The worldwide flood of Noah's day.
- 2. Which of the Seven C's of History is this Catastrophe? The third.
- 3. Which two C's came before the Catastrophe? Creation and Corruption.
- 4. Why did God send this great catastrophe—the flood? Because of sin in the world, the wickedness of men.
- 5. Why did God save Noah? He was obedient, righteous, wanted to please God.
- 6. God brought all kinds of animals to the ark. Which animals were not on the ark? Sea Creatures. Fish.
- 7. What is a "clean" animal? An animal used for sacrifice to God (e.g., cows, sheep, goats, rams).
- 8. How many pairs of clean animals did God bring to Noah? Two or seven? Seven.
- 9. Who was on the ark? How many people were there? Noah and his family. Eight people.
- 10. What happened to the rest of the people on the earth? They died.
- **11.** Where did the water come from that flooded the earth? From below the earth ("the fountains of the great deep") and the heavens above (rain).
- 12. How did the animals get to the ark before the flood? God brought them to Noah.
- 13. There were lots of land animals and flying creatures left on the earth. Which of them died in the flood? All of them.
- 14. There were lots of people left on the earth. Which of them died in the flood? All of them.
- 15. What bird helped Noah know when there was dry land again after the flood? A dove.
- 16. What did the dove bring back to Noah the second time he sent her out from the ark? An olive leaf.
- 17. How long were Noah and his family on the ark before the Lord told them it was safe to leave? Over a year. 371 days.
