## Instructions

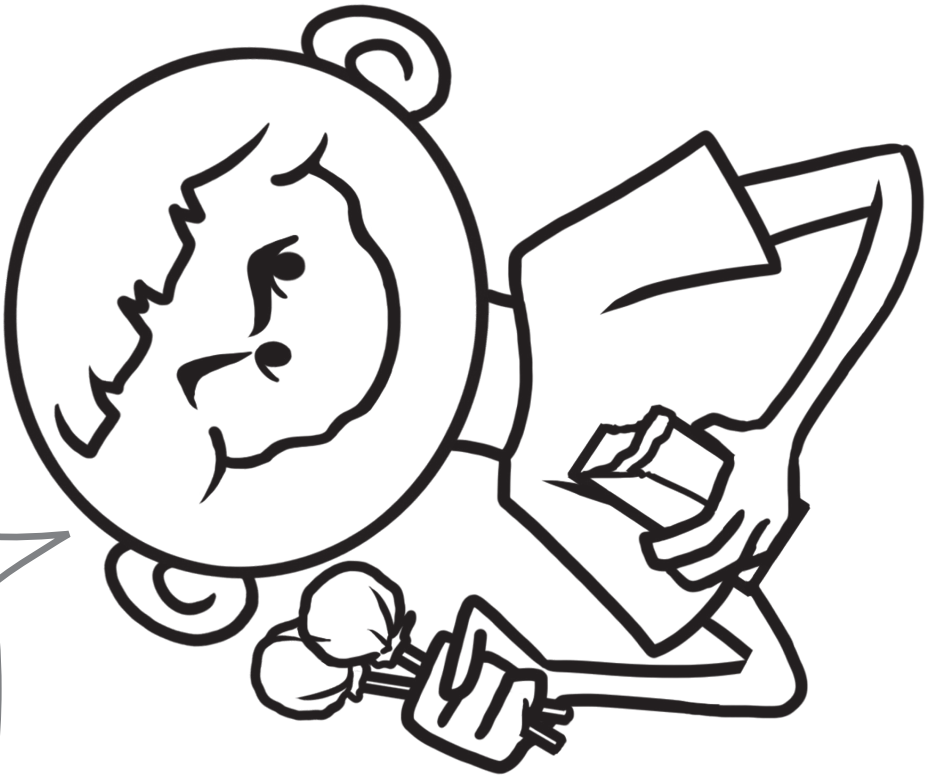

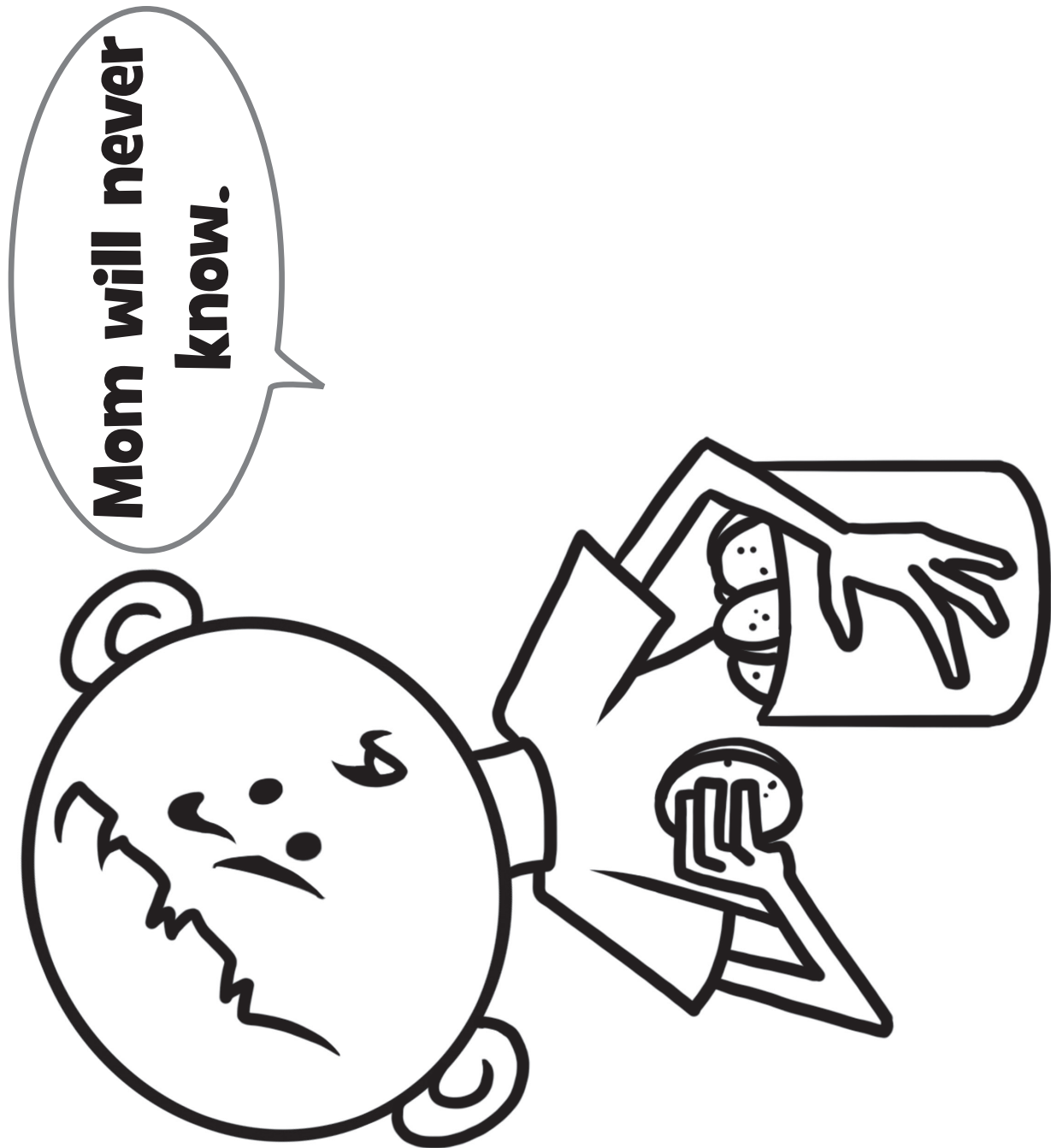
## Suggested Discussion

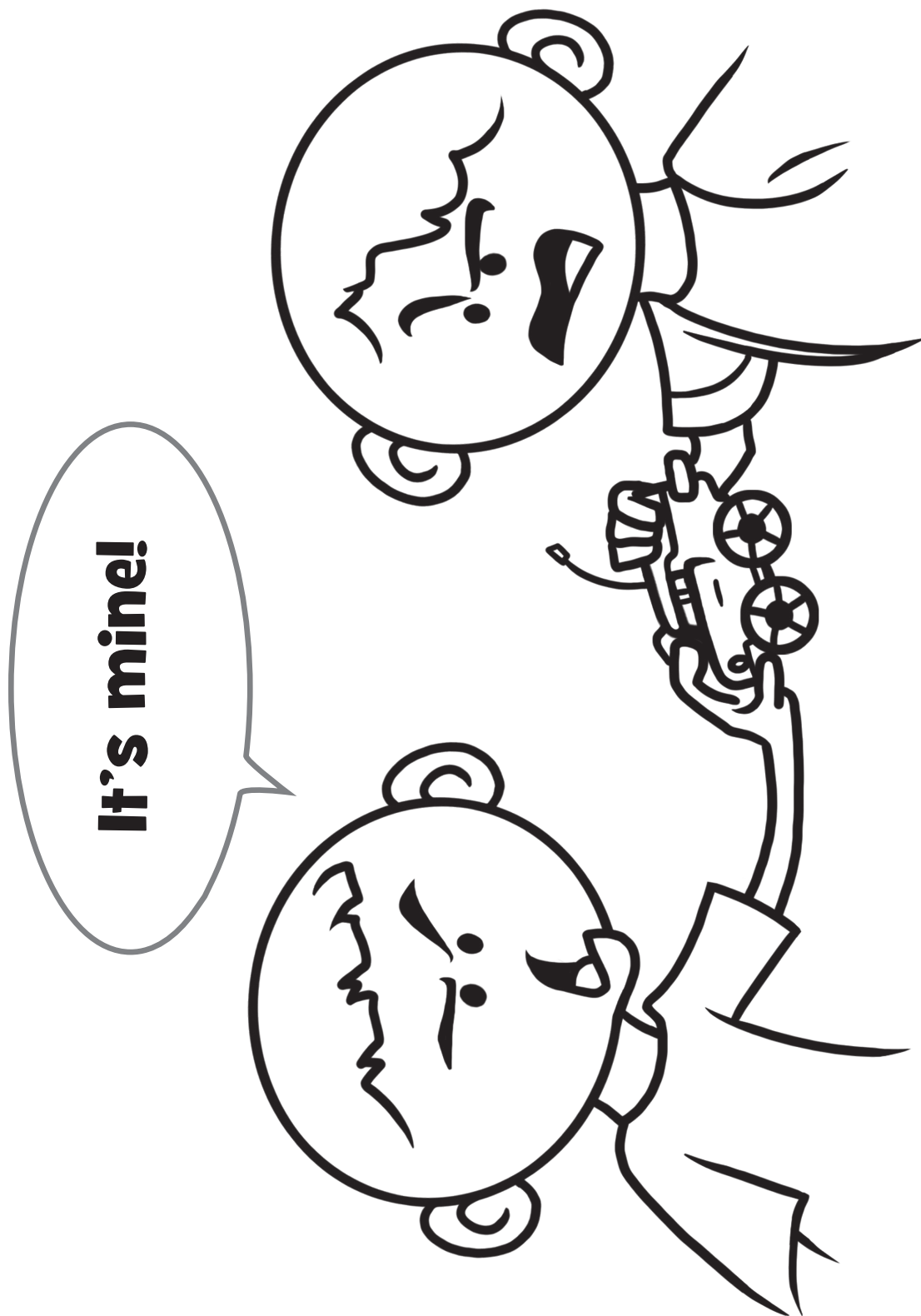
The Bible tells us we are all sinners. We have a hard time doing what's right.

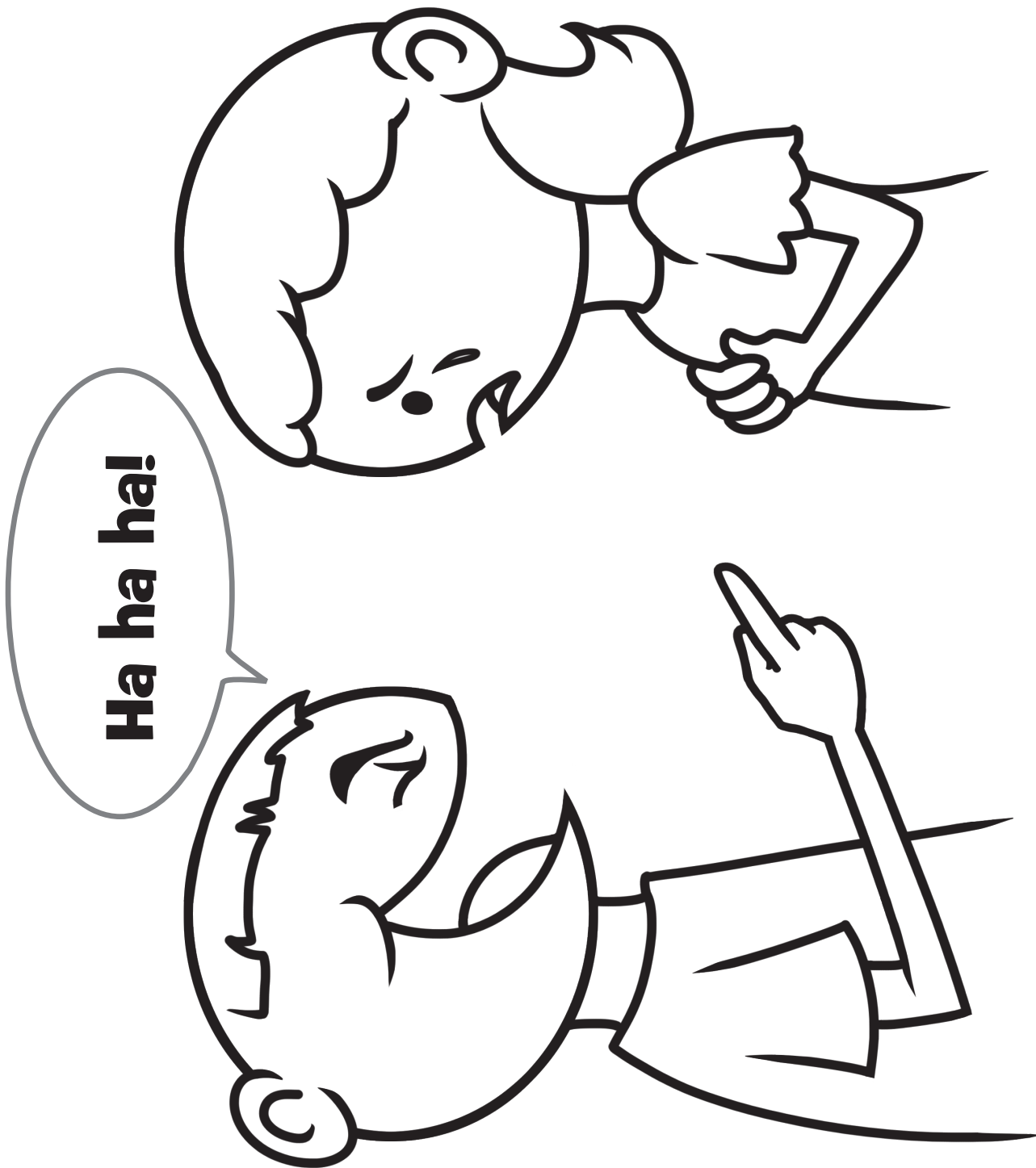

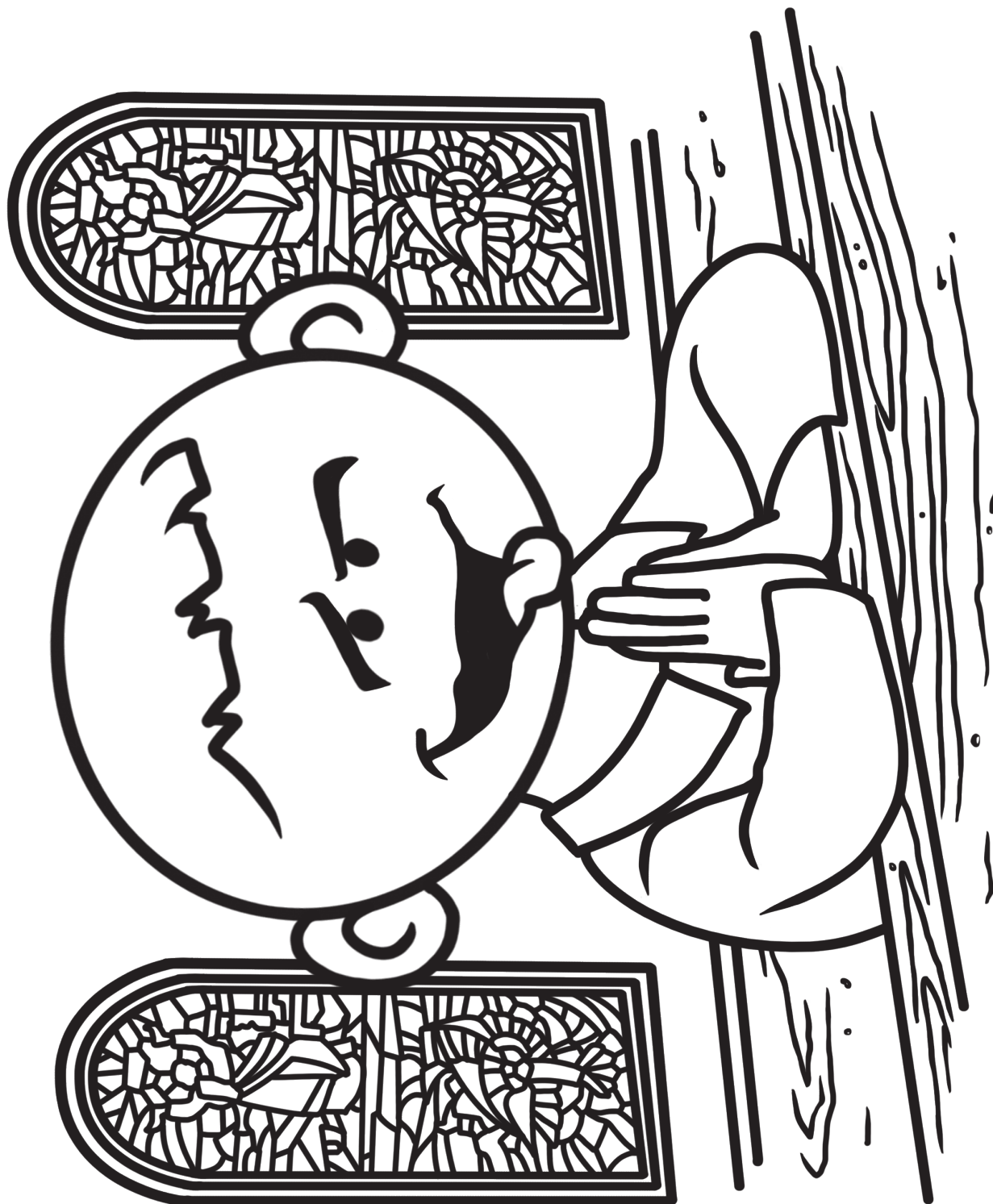
