## **Review Questions**

- 1. We talked about the fourth C of the Seven C's of History today. What was that C? Confusion.
- 2. When in history did the confusion happen? About 110 years after the flood of Noah's Day.
- 3. What did God command the people to do when they got off the ark? Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth. Have families and spread around the world.
- 4. How many languages were in the world at this time? One.
- 5. The people wanted to make a name for themselves. What did they begin to build? A city and a tower.
- 6. How big did the people want to make their tower? With its top in the heavens.
- 7. The people did not want to fill the earth. They sinned against God. What does God think of all sin? He hates it. He must punish it.
- **8.** How did God punish the people? He confused their language by creating many languages so they couldn't understand each other.
- 9. What did the people have to stop doing because they didn't understand each other? They stopped building the city and the tower.
- 10. And what did they do? They left Babel and scattered around the world.
- **11.** The family groups who left Babel together eventually formed what that we have today? Nations, people groups.
- 12. What kind of tower do we think Babel looked like? We looked at a map with copies of it all over the world. *Ziggurat*.
- 13. What buildings do we find in Egypt that could be copies of the ancient tower at Babel? Pyramids.
- 14. These copies of the tower of Babel can't be older than how many years because that was when God scattered the people? 4,300.
- **15. Why did God confuse the language at Babel?** The people had sinned against him. This was his punishment and his way to get them to move around the world.
- **16. Who can say "hello" in a language besides English that we used today?** Allow several students to say "hello" in French, German, Italian, Spanish, or Taiwanese.
