Review Questions

- 1. Whose idea was it to build a permanent house of worship to God? David's.
- **2.** What did David do to help prepare for the building of the temple? He collected materials from the people. He recorded the plans God gave him for the design of the temple.
- 3. Who did David give the temple plans to? His son Solomon.
- 4. What kind of wood did Solomon use a lot of in the temple: pine, cedar, or oak? Cedar.
- 5. God promised to dwell in the temple if the people remained faithful and what? Obedient.
- 6. How many years did it take to complete the temple: 3, 5, or 7? 7.
- 7. Where did the Israelites worship and offer sacrifices before the temple was built? *Tabernacle*.
- 8. Was the tabernacle a portable or permanent structure? *Portable*.
- 9. What were the two rooms in the tent of meeting in the tabernacle? Holy Place and Most Holy Place.
- **10.** What rooms were in the temple? Holy Place (nave), Most Holy Place (inner sanctuary), storage rooms, inner and upper chambers.
- 11. What is the vestibule: a storage room, a porch, or a door? A porch.
- **12.** Name one of the furnishings in both the tabernacle and the temple. (Allow several students to answer.) Altar, basin (sea), table for bread, lampstand, altar of incense, ark of the covenant.
- 13. How many tables and lampstands were in the Holy Place of the temple? 10 each.
- 14. Which room was reserved for the ark of the covenant? Most Holy Place (inner sanctuary).
- 15. Who was the only person allowed in the Most Holy Place once a year? The high priest.
- **16. What was the altar used for?** Offering animal sacrifices as a temporary covering for sin.
- 17. What furnishing in the temple courtyard held the water the priests used for washing? *The sea (basin)*.
- 18. What separated the rooms in the temple: veils or doors? Doors.
- 19. What precious metal was used for much of the temple and its furnishings? Gold.
- 20. When the ark was placed in the temple, what did God send to show his presence? Cloud.
- 21. What does our memory verse say we should ask God for? Wisdom.
