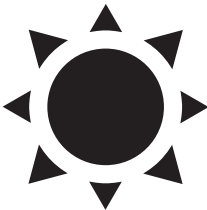


The forecast calls for a big snowfall tonight, so school might be cancelled tomorrow. Would you trust the forecast and skip doing your homework?
