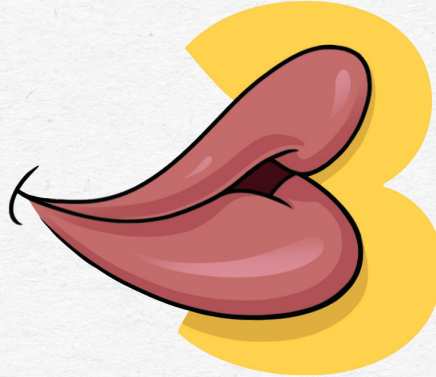
1. Put God first.

Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.



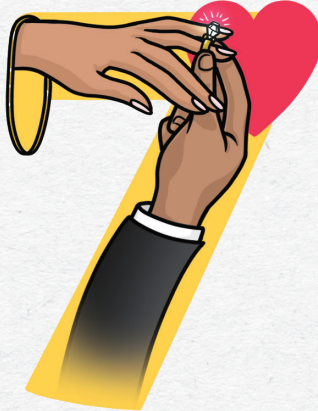
5. Obey your parents.
