5. In Matthew 1:1, what two Old Testament men are listed as part of Jesus' family? *David and Abraham.*
6. What title did Matthew use for Jesus to show he was the promised Messiah, the eternal King: Son of David, Son of God, or Son of Man? *Son of David.*
