OutWord *For Family Discussion*

What if your friend said that he didn't think God would ever forgive all the bad things he had done? **What could you say?**

Everybody does bad things, or sins. You may think you've committed too many sins to be forgiven, but that's not true. God is able to forgive you. God must judge sin, and a penalty must be paid in order for your sins to be forgiven. But the good news is that God sent his Son, Jesus, to pay the penalty for your sins so you don't have to. If you ask God to forgive you, turn away from your sins, and trust in Jesus Christ to be your Savior, he WILL forgive all your sins. Then you can start fresh, walking in obedience to God!
