- 1. What do we call the commands God gave Moses and the Israelites at Mount Sinai? The Ten Commandments.
- 2. What did God write the Ten Commandments on? Two stone tablets.
- 3. How long was Moses up on the mountain: 40 hours, 40 days, or 4 months? 40 days.
- 4. What did the Israelites want Aaron to make for them? False gods, idol.
- 5. What did the Israelites give Aaron to make the idol? Gold rings.
- 6. What did the idol that Aaron made look like? A golden calf.
- 7. Why was it a sin for the Israelites to make and worship the golden calf? They were breaking the first two commandments God gave them.
- 8. What did the Israelites give the golden calf credit for that God had done? Bringing them out of Egypt.
- 9. What was God going to do to punish the Israelites for their idolatry? Destroy them.
- **10.** What did Moses do when God told him about the Israelites' sin? He prayed and asked God to show mercy.
- **11.** How did God show mercy to the Israelites? He did not destroy all the Israelites.
- 12. What did Moses do when he came down the mountain and saw the golden calf and the people acting out of control? He broke the stone tablets with the Ten Commandments.
- **13. What did Moses do to the golden calf?** Burned it, ground it up, and made the people drink the powder.
