Fluffy Lamb Puppet

Materials

- ☐ Lamb face and ears (following page)
- ☐ Paper plates
- ☐ Cotton balls
- ☐ Craft sticks
- ☐ Crayons
- ☐ Glue
- ☐ Optional: plastic wiggle eyes

Instructions

Print and cut out one lamb face and one set of ears for each student or let students do the cutting. Have students color their lamb face and glue it in the center on the back of their paper plate. Add ears to the top edge of the plate a few inches to the right and left of the face. Optional: add plastic wiggle eyes.


Glue one craft stick at the bottom of the plate for a puppet handle. Finally, have students glue cotton balls all over the plate, around the face and ears, and over the top end of the stick. Allow glue to dry before using the puppet.

Suggested Discussion

In today's lesson, Nathan used a story to help David understand that he had sinned, and God knew about it.

- Who was the rich man supposed to be? David.
- Who was the poor man? Uriah, Bathsheba's husband.
- And who was the little lamb that was taken? Bathsheba.
- Right. Did David understand what he did wrong? Yes.
