Review Questions

- 1. What was Moses doing on the mountain when he saw the burning bush? He was caring for the flock (animals) of his father-in-law.
- 2. What did God tell Moses to remove when he came near the burning bush? His sandals.
- 3. Why was Moses supposed to remove his sandals? He was on holy ground.
- **4.** What task did God give Moses? To lead the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt.
- **5.** Where did God promise to bring the Israelites? To the Promised Land. To Canaan. To a land flowing with milk and honey.
- 6. Who would deliver the Israelites? *God.*
- 7. What were some of Moses' objections to his calling? Allow several students to answer. He felt like he wasn't the right man for the job. He didn't know what name for God to tell the Israelites. He didn't think the Israelites would believe that God appeared to him. He wasn't a good speaker.
- 8. What attributes of God do we learn from the name I AM? Eternal, independent, and immutable.
- 9. Which attribute means that God will never change? *Immutable*.
- **10.** While speaking to Moses, why did God refer to himself as the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob? *To remind Moses that he would keep his promises (covenant) to Abraham and his descendants.*
- **11.** Name one of the three signs God gave Moses to show the Israelites. Allow several students to answer. Staff turned into a serpent (snake), hand covered with leprosy and then restored, and water turned into blood.
- 12. What did Moses do when God first turned his staff into a snake? He ran away from it.
- 13. Who did God prepare to help Moses because he was worried about speaking? His brother, Aaron.
- **14.** Why did God get angry at Moses? Because Moses asked God to send someone else.
- 15. How should we respond when God tells us to do something? Obey right away!
- 16. When Moses obeyed God and returned to Egypt with his family, how did the Israelite leaders respond when they heard from him and saw the signs? They believed God and worshipped him.
- 17. What's the reference of our memory verse? Isaiah 41:10.
- **18.** According to the memory verse, why do we not need to fear or be dismayed? Because God is with us and he is our God.
