Instructions

Choose one student to sit in a chair at the front of the room. Have him choose an object in the room without pointing it out and whisper it to you. Have the student describe the object by giving hints one at a time, allowing the class to guess the object between hints. Limit the time to 1-2 minutes or limit the amount of hints before revealing the object.

Suggested Discussion

Some of these things were hard to describe, weren't they? Even though they were things that you all had seen before right here in this room, it was still hard to get your friends to understand exactly what you were talking about.
