## **Review Questions**

- 1. How many C's do we use to remember the history of the world according to the Bible? Seven.
- **2. Which four C's are recorded in the book of Genesis?** (Ask several students.) Creation, Corruption, Catastrophe, and Confusion.
- 3. Malachi prophesied that a messenger would come to prepare the way for the Lord. Who was the messenger? *John the Baptist*.
- 4. How many years passed between Malachi and the Gospels in the New Testament: 40, 400, or 4,000? 400 years.
- 5. God gave the first message about Jesus the Savior right after what event in the garden of Eden? *Corruption. Adam and Eve sinned against God.*
- 6. How was Jesus "bruised" or hurt by Satan when he came to earth? He died on the cross.
- 7. How did Jesus "bruise" or defeat Satan? He rose from the dead.
- 8. What is the message about the Messiah in the Old Testament? The Messiah will come/is coming.
- 9. God promised that whose descendants would be as numerous as the stars: Moses', Noah's, or Abraham's? *Abraham*'s.
- 10. God promised that one of Abraham's descendants would bless all the nations of the earth. Who was he talking about? The Messiah, Jesus, who died for the sins of the whole world.
- 11. The blood of the Passover lambs saved the Israelites from the death of the firstborn (plague). How was Jesus' blood like the lambs' blood? Jesus' blood was shed on the cross to save us from eternal death (hell).
- **12.** How do the Ten Commandments remind us that we need a Savior? No one can keep them all the time. They show us our sin.
- 13. Which king was given the promise that the Messiah would come from his descendants and rule forever: Saul, David, or Solomon? *David*.
- **14.** What does Isaiah 53:5 say about how the Messiah would take the punishment for our sins? He would be pierced and crushed for our sins; he would suffer and die on the cross.
- 15. What is the message of the New Testament about the Messiah? The Messiah has come.
- 16. What title used for Jesus in the New Testament means he is the anointed one, the promised Messiah? *Christ*.
- 17. What two men are listed as Jesus' ancestors in Matthew 1:1: Adam and David, Abraham and Moses, or Abraham and David? Abraham and David.
- **18.** What do we mean when we say that Jesus purifies us? He forgives us and cleanses us of sin/removes the stain of sin.
- 19. Who is the link that connects the Old and the New Testaments? *Jesus*.
- 20. The time when God promises a new heaven and a new earth for all believers is called what: Creation, Consummation, or Confusion? It's the seventh C. Consummation.
