# **Review Questions**

#### Lesson 101

- 1. The southern kingdom of Judah was ruled by whose descendants? King David's.
- 2. Which queen decided she should rule Judah and began killing all the princes? *Athaliah*.
- 3. Which prince was rescued by Jehosheba and hidden in the temple for six years? *Joash.*
- 4. How old was Joash when he was crowned king by the priest Jehoiada? Seven years old.
- 5. Name one good and one evil thing Joash did during his reign. He obeyed God's laws and restored the temple when Jehoiada was alive. After Jehoiada's death, Joash worshipped false gods and ordered the death of Jehoiada's son, Zechariah.

#### Lesson 102

- 6. What good king of Judah was reigning when King Sennacherib and the Assyrians surrounded the city? *Hezekiah*.
- 7. What did King Sennacherib do to try to scare Hezekiah and his people into surrendering? He sent the Rabshakeh and his army to surround Jerusalem and tell the people God and the king wouldn't save them. He sent a letter saying he would destroy Jerusalem just like all the other cities he'd conquered.
- 8. What did King Hezekiah do with the letter from King Sennacherib? He took it into the temple before the Lord and prayed for help.
- 9. What prophet delivered God's response to King Hezekiah? *Isaiah*.
- **10.** How did God save Hezekiah and the people of Jerusalem? The angel of the Lord killed 185,000 Assyrian soldiers at night, forcing Sennacherib to leave Judah.

### Lesson 103

11. Which of the minor prophets recorded that the coming ruler would be born in Bethlehem: Jonah, Micah, or Obadiah? *Micah*.

- 12. Which of the major prophets recorded that the Messiah's birth would be a miraculous virgin birth? *Isaiah*.
- 13. Who was chosen by God to be the mother of Jesus, the Savior? *Mary*.
- **14. Why is Jesus called our Savior?** His death and resurrection provided a way for us to be saved from our sins. He died as a perfect sacrifice for the sins of the world.
- 15. The prophecies of Isaiah and Micah were written about how many years before Jesus came to fulfill them: 70, 700, or 7,000? 700.
- 16. Name an attribute of God that is shown through the fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies in the New Testament. Faithful (God kept his promise to send a Savior), sovereign (God was in control of everything), omniscient (God knows everything—past, present, and future).

## Lesson 104

- 17. Who became king of Judah at age eight? Josiah.
- 18. Does the Bible say that Josiah was a good or an evil king? *Good*.
- 19. Name one of the good things Josiah did during his reign. He determined to follow the Lord; he cleansed the land of idolatry; he repaired the temple.
- 20. What was found in the temple during Josiah's reign? The Book of the Law.
- 21. How did Josiah respond when he heard the laws of God that he and the people had broken? He was grieved (tore his clothes) and promised to follow (obey) the Lord.

#### Lesson 105

- 22. Who did God send to warn his people to turn back to him when they were sinning? *Prophets*.
- 23. What prophet did God send to the potter's house to see a vessel be remade? *Jeremiah*.

- 24. What message did God want the people of Judah to get from the potter and the clay? The people needed to repent of idolatry before they were destroyed like the spoiled clay and then remade into another vessel.
- 25. What is Jeremiah sometimes called because he mourned over the people's stubbornness and rebellion against God? *The weeping prophet*.

## Lesson 106

- 26. What message did Jeremiah deliver from God that made the people upset? An enemy, the Babylonians, would defeat Judah.
- **27.** How did the people punish Jeremiah? *They beat him, imprisoned him, and threw him in a pit (cistern).*
- 28. Who rescued Jeremiah from the pit? Ebed-melech.
- 29. What king was reigning when Jerusalem fell to the Babylonians: Hezekiah, Josiah, or Zedekiah? *Zedekiah*.
- 30. What did the Babylonians do with the people who survived the destruction of the city? Took them into exile; made them live in another land far from home.
- 31. Who did God protect from the Babylonians? *Jeremiah, Ebed-melech, other exiles.*

#### Lesson 107

- 32. Give the Hebrew name of one of the four young men who were taken from Judah to Babylon to serve the king. (Ask several students.)

  Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, Azariah.
- 33. Why were the young men given new names? The king wanted them to forget their God, people, and country and serve only him.
- 34. Why did Daniel and his friends not want to eat the king's food and drink his wine? It was food that had been dedicated to idols (false gods). It was food that was against God's laws for the Hebrew people to eat.
- 35. What did Daniel suggest to the eunuch as a test? That he and his friends eat vegetables and drink water for 10 days and then be compared to the other young men who ate the king's food.

- 36. How did God reward Daniel and his friends for being obedient to him? They won the test and were allowed to continue their diet of vegetables and water. God blessed them with wisdom and high positions serving the king.
- **37.** What special ability did God give Daniel? *To understand/interpret dreams.*

## Lesson 108

- 38. What did King Nebuchadnezzar command all the people to worship? A golden image.
- 39. Who refused to bow down and worship when the music played? Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.
- 40. What punishment did they face for refusing to worship the golden image? Being thrown into the fiery furnace.
- **41.** What happened when the three men were thrown into the furnace? God protected them from harm; Jesus/an angel appeared and walked around in the furnace with them.
- **42.** How did God humble King Nebuchadnezzar after he had been warned in a dream? He was forced away from people to live like an animal for seven years until he acknowledged God as sovereign.

#### Lesson 109

- 43. What king of Babylon used the holy vessels (cups) from the temple for his guests to drink from? *Belshazzar*
- **44.** What did God do to warn Belshazzar his kingdom would end? Sent a hand to write a message on the wall.
- 45. Who interpreted the writing on the wall for King Belshazzar? *Daniel*.
- 46. What happened to fulfill the message of the writing on the wall? The Babylonians fell to the Medo-Persian army, and Belshazzar was killed.
- 47. What king was tricked into signing a law that no one could pray to anyone but the king for 30 days? *Darius*.
- **48.** How did God protect Daniel in the lions' den?

  He sent an angel to close the lions' mouths and keep

  Daniel alive.
