- 1. What is a genealogy? The study of a family tree.
- 2. What book of the Bible records the genealogies we used to calculate the age of the earth? Genesis.
- 3. Why is Adam listed first in the genealogies? He was the first man created by God.
- 4. How old was Adam when he died: 330, 630, or 930 years? 930.
- 5. How many years were there between Adam and Abraham? About 2,000 years.
- 6. In the genealogies from Genesis 5 and 11, who was the oldest when he had a son: Adam, Methuselah, or Noah? *Noah* (he was 502).
- 7. How many years were there between Abraham and when Jesus was born? About 2,000.
- 8. How long ago did Jesus live? About 2,000 years ago.
- 9. How many years between Adam and us? About 6,000 years.
- **10. What is radiometric dating?** *The way some scientists date rocks and the age of the earth.*
- **11.** What do people who believe evolution say about how the earth began? There was a big bang in space about 4–5 billion years ago and all things evolved over billions of years.
- 12. How old do some scientists tell us the earth is according to radiometric dating? Billions of years old.
- 13. What was the problem with the age evolutionary scientists came up with for the Mount St. Helens' rock? Some said it was thousands of years old, but it was only 10 years old.
