

Card 1

Herald: The king has commanded all people of Babylon to worship his golden statue. Whenever you hear music playing, you must fall down before it. Whoever does not bow down and worship the statue will be thrown into a burning fiery furnace.

Card 4

Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego:

O king, our God can save us from the fiery furnace, and he will save us from you! But even if he doesn't, we still will not serve your gods or worship the golden statue.

Card 2

Babylonians: O king, there are certain Jewish men—Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego—who are paying no attention to your command. They will not serve your gods or worship the golden statue that you set up.

Card 5

King Nebuchadnezzar: Heat the furnace seven times hotter than usual! Guards, tie up these men and throw them into the fiery furnace!

Card 3

King Nebuchadnezzar: Obey now or be thrown into the fiery furnace! What god can save you now?

Card 6

King Nebuchadnezzar: Weren't there three men that we tied up and threw into the furnace? I see four men walking around in the fire—untied. They are not hurt. And the fourth man looks like a son of the gods!
