K-1st Review Questions

- 1. What book of history in the Old Testament did we read from today: 2 Kings or 1 Chronicles? 2 Kings.
- 2. How long did God wait for Israel to turn from their sins: 10 years, 25 years, or 250 years? 250 years.
- 3. What did God promise to send against Israel to punish them: a storm or an enemy? An enemy.
- 4. What was the name of the king who attacked Israel: Hosea or Shalmaneser? *Shalmaneser*.
- 5. What country was Israel's enemy from: Assyria or India? Assyria.
- 6. What word means to take over a city by circling around it so that no one could get in or out: besiege or defend? Besiege.
- 7. The Assyrians besieged Israel's capital city. What was the name of the city: Bethlehem or Samaria? Samaria.
- 8. No one could go in or out of the city, so the people ran out of what? Food and water; supplies.
- 9. How long did the Assyrians stay at Samaria: three days, three weeks, or three years? *Three years*.
- 10. What happened to most of the Israelite people? Did the Assyrians take them away or let them stay at home? *Took them away.*
- 11. Why did God punish Israel? What did the people do against the Lord? Sinned.
- 12. The people of Israel had been worshipping what? *Idols; false gods.*
- 13. Whom did God send to warn the Israelites to turn back to him: priests or prophets? *Prophets*.
- 14. What did the people do after the prophets warned them? Did they obey or did they not listen? *They did not listen*.
- 15. How did God feel when the Israelites would not listen? *Angry.*
- 16. Which word means that God cannot sin and that he hates sin? *Holy.*
- 17. God is just, and he must punish what? Sin.
- 18. Can you say the memory verse? Proverbs 3:11–12 "My son, do not despise the LORD's discipline or be weary of his reproof, for the LORD reproves him whom he loves, as a father the son in whom he delights." (ESV)
