God Is Sovereign Wall Ribbon

Materials


Construction	paper	cut into	4x6-inch
rectangles			

- ☐ Cutouts printed on card stock (following pages)
- ☐ Markers or colored pencils
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Glue, glue sticks, or stapler
- ☐ Hole punch
- ☐ Wide ribbon in 30-inch lengths (do not use sheer)
- ☐ Narrow ribbon or yarn
- ☐ Optional: construction paper cut into 3x3-inch squares

Instructions

Print on card stock and cut one set of cutouts for each student or have students do the cutting if appropriate. Have students color the cutouts.

Give each student one piece of wide ribbon (30 inches long) and one rectangle of construction paper (4x6 inches). Have students glue the "sovereign" sign onto the construction paper to make a frame around the sign. Apply a small amount of glue to the top of the ribbon then press the sign onto the ribbon. In the same way, glue the pictures all the way down the ribbon about 1 inch apart, or you may want to staple the sign and the cutouts to the



ribbon instead of gluing. NOTE: Do not use sheer ribbon or the glue will seep through.

Hole punch the sign near the top two corners. Put narrow ribbon or yarn through the two holes in the sign to make a loop for hanging.

Option: To add more color, you may want to glue 3x3-inch squares of construction paper behind each picture for a framed look.

Suggested Discussion
