Instructions

Print, cut apart, and pass out the cue cards to four volunteers and have each come to the front one at a time. Ask each volunteer the question, "What did you think of your day at the fair?" Have them respond by reading their cue card.

After all four cards are read, guide the class to discuss the similarities and differences of each person's report using the suggested discussion below. After the discussion, continue with the lesson.

Option: If you have only Pre-K students, or if you don't have any volunteers to assist you, introduce the idea by saying, "We're going to find out what each of these kids thought about their day at the fair." Read each card to the class then lead the discussion.

Suggested Discussion

Although each person went to the same event, they each focused on the things that were important to them.

- **?** What were some of the same things they each mentioned? All four went to the fair; they each rode at least one ride; they all walked through the animal barns, ate ice cream, and said it rained.
- **?** What were some of the different things they mentioned? Some enjoyed different activities more than others; different animals caught their attention; descriptions of food were different; some added personal feelings to describe their experiences; the order of events were different.
- ? Did anyone say anything contradictory? Did anyone tell a lie about something, such as saying it never rained or that there was no ice cream available? No. No one lied. They all make sense with each other
