- 1. What "first" did we discuss today? Sin.
- 2. Which C in the Seven C's of History stands for when sin entered the world? *Corruption*.
- 3. Who committed that very first sin? Adam and Eve.
- 4. Who tempted Eve to sin? The serpent/Satan.
- 5. What did the serpent do to trick Eve into disobeying God? What did he change? *God's Word.*
- **6.** What tree in the garden did God command Adam and Eve not to eat from? The tree of the knowledge of good and evil.
- 7. Adam and Eve tried to cover themselves with fig leaves. It didn't work. So what did God do? Killed an animal(s) to make clothes for them.
- 8. Which attributes of God explain why God hates sin and must punish it? Holy and just.
