1. What “first” did we discuss today? *Sin.*
2. Which C in the Seven C’s of History stands for when sin entered the world? *Corruption.*
3. Who committed that very first sin? *Adam and Eve.*
4. Who tempted Eve to sin? *The serpent/Satan.*
5. What did the serpent do to trick Eve into disobeying God? What did he change? *God’s Word.*
6. What tree in the garden did God command Adam and Eve not to eat from? *The tree of the knowledge of good and evil.*
7. Adam and Eve tried to cover themselves with fig leaves. It didn’t work. So what did God do? *Killed an animal(s) to make clothes for them.*
8. Which attributes of God explain why God hates sin and must punish it? *Holy and just.*
9. What did the sin of Adam and Eve bring into the world? *Death.*
10. What word did we learn that means hatred would come between the woman and the serpent? *Enmity.*
11. Where did Adam and Eve have to leave as a consequence of their sin? *The garden of Eden.*
12. Which sins must God punish? *All sins.*
13. Who sins today? *All people.*
14. According to Hebrews 9:22, what does forgiveness of sins require? *Shedding of blood.*
15. What did God do for sinners? *Sent Jesus to die on the cross.*
16. What kind of a sacrifice was Jesus? *A perfect sacrifice.*
17. What made Jesus the perfect sacrifice? *He had never sinned.*

19. Who can say all four verses, Psalm 8:3–6? *Allow several students to try the whole passage.*
