| Star stickers (11 for each student) |
| Yellow or brown yarn or straw cut into 2–3-inch lengths |
| Glue sticks |
| Scissors |
| Tape |

Instructions

Print both activity sheets for each student. Have students stick 11 star stickers on the sheet with Joseph and the moon and sun. On the other sheet, have students glue yarn or straw onto the sheaves. Allow students to color the rest of the pictures then glue or tape the sheets together back-to-back or side-to-side if desired.

Suggested Discussion

God gave Joseph some special dreams. Joseph dreamed that the sun, moon, and stars would bow to him. The other dream was about all his brothers' sheaves of grain bowing to his sheaf.

Both of the dreams meant that Joseph's family would bow to him someday. Joseph would rule over them. But how could that happen? We'll learn more about this in our next lessons.
