1. True or false: Moses got to enter the promised land. *False.*
2. Where did God have Moses go to see the promised land before he died? *A mountain.*
3. Who did God choose to lead the Israelites after Moses died? *Joshua.*
4. God commanded Joshua to be strong and what? *Courageous.*
5. What city did Joshua send the two spies to? *Jericho.*
6. What woman hid the spies on her roof? *Rahab.*
7. Where was Rahab's house located? *In the wall of the city.*
8. Who found out about the spies and sent men to capture them? *King of Jericho.*
9. Where did Rahab tell the king's men that the spies had gone? *Out the gate of the city.*
10. How did Rahab help the spies escape the city and the men chasing them? *She let them down her window with a rope. She told them to hide in the hills for three days.*
11. Why were the people in Jericho terrified of the Israelites? What had they heard about God? *They knew about the parting of the Red Sea and the Israelites' victories over the Amorite kings Sihon and Og.*
12. What did Rahab believe about the Israelites' God when she heard about his miracles? *That he was the one true God who had power over the heavens and the earth.*
13. What did the spies tell Rahab to do so she and her family would be spared when they took over the city? *Tie a scarlet cord in her window. Gather all her family inside her house. Not tell her people their plans to attack.*
14. What attribute of God was shown by Joshua and the people keeping their promise to spare Rahab and her family? *Mercy. Faithfulness.*
15. Rahab married an Israelite. What two important people came from her family? *King David. Jesus.*
16. Rahab is listed in Hebrews 11 because of her what—courage, faith, or holiness? *Faith.*
17. Name one reason Rahab is an unlikely hero to be used by God. *Ask several students. She had a sinful background. She was a prostitute. She was a Gentile. She lived in a wicked city.*
18. Who can say the memory verse, Deuteronomy 7:9? *Allow several students to recite the verse.*

Bonus: What made Jericho a tough city to attack? *It was protected by walls.*
