- 1. Who led the first group of Jewish exiles back to Judah: Cyrus, Ezra, or Zerubbabel? Zerubbabel.
- 2. How many years did God tell the Jews they would be captives in Babylon? 70 years.
- 3. Who led the second group of Jewish exiles back to Judah? Ezra.
- **4.** What was Ezra's job? He was a priest and a scribe.
- 5. What did Ezra want to do with the Law of God? Study it, do it, and teach others about it.
- 6. Which king of Persia gave Ezra permission to return to Judah: Artaxerxes, Cyrus, or Darius? *Artaxerxes*.
- 7. What did God protect Ezra and the Jews from on the journey to Jerusalem: enemies, sore feet, or sickness? *Enemies*.
- 8. What attribute means that God will always keep his promises? Faithful.
- **9.** When Ezra got to Judah, what sin had the Jews in the land committed? They had married foreign people who worshipped false gods.
- **10.** Why was marrying foreign people a sin for the Jews? God had commanded them not to. They were breaking God's laws. They were committing idolatry.
- **11.** How did Ezra show his distress over the Jews' sin? What did he do? He tore his clothes and pulled out his hair and sat appalled.
- 12. In Ezra's first prayer to God when he discovered the Jews' sin, did he give praise to God, confess the sin and guilt of the people, or bless the people? He confessed the sin and guilt of the people.
- **13.** What did God warn his people would happen if they married foreign people? Their hearts would be turned away from following God to false gods.
- **14.** When the Jews saw Ezra weeping and praying because of their sin, what did they do? *They wept bitterly because of their sin.*
- **15.** Why were the people weeping? They recognized their great sin before God and were sorry for it.
- **16.** When the people gathered outside by the temple several days later, why were they trembling? *Because of their sin and the heavy rain.*
- **17.** What did Ezra tell the people they must do to make things right? Confess their sin, do the Lord's will, and separate themselves from the people of the land.
- **18.** How did the Jews separate themselves from the foreign people? They sent away their foreign spouses and children.
- **19.** What did the Jews do that was right when they learned they'd sinned and broken God's laws? They were repentant (sorrowful) over their sin. They did what was hard to make things right and separated themselves from those who were leading them to sin.
- 20. Which group of Jewish exiles had set a bad example by marrying foreigners? Priests and leaders.
