Review Questions

- 1. What did God use to get Moses' attention out in the desert of Midian? A burning bush.
- 2. What was Moses doing out in the desert? Shepherding his father-in-law's flock.
- 3. What was strange about this burning bush? It wasn't burning up.
- 4. What did God tell Moses to remove when he came near the burning bush? His sandals. Shoes.
- **5.** Why was Moses supposed to remove his sandals? To show respect. He was on holy ground.
- 6. What job did God give Moses? To lead the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt.
- 7. Why would this be a difficult task? The Egyptians wouldn't want to let their slaves leave. Moses would have to speak to Pharoah, the king.
- **8. Why did Moses ask for God's name?** So he would know what to say when the Israelites asked for God's name.
- 9. What did God answer when Moses asked for his name? | AM WHO | AM.
- **10.** What attributes of God do we learn from the name I AM? Allow several students to answer. Eternal, independent, and immutable.
- **11.** Name one of the three signs God gave Moses to show the Israelites. Allow several students to answer. Staff turned into a serpent, hand covered with leprosy and then restored, and water turned into blood.
- 12. Who did God bring to help Moses because he was worried about speaking? Moses' brother, Aaron.
- **13. Why did God get angry at Moses?** Because Moses asked God to send someone else.
- **14.** How should we respond when God tells us to do something? Obey right away!
- 15. When Moses obeyed God and returned to Egypt with his family, how did the Israelite leaders respond when they heard from him and saw the signs? They believed God and worshipped him.
- **16.** How do we learn what God wants us to know? Name one way God speaks to us today. *Bible, Holy Spirit, sermons, teaching, prayer, etc.*
- 17. What is the reference of our memory verse? Where do we find it in the Bible? Isaiah 41:10.
- 18. What does God say not to do in the memory verse? Fear not, do not be dismayed.
