



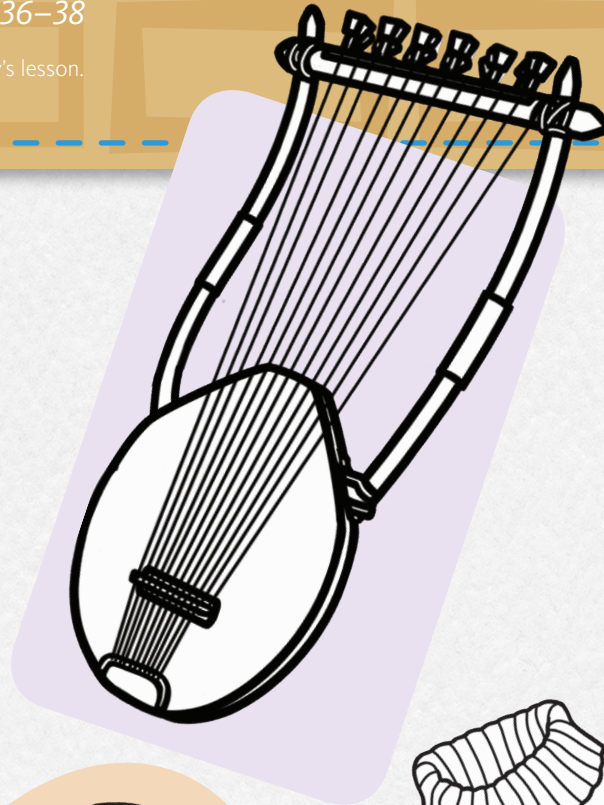
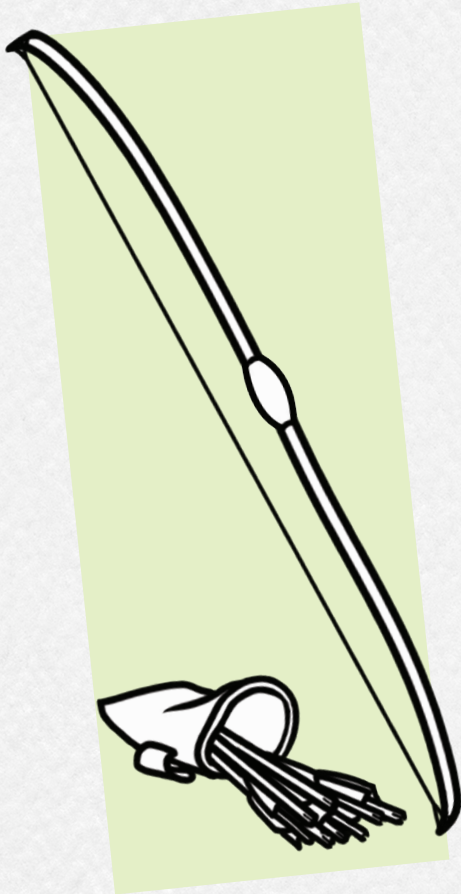

What You Heard *In the Word*

2. What did Saul do with his spear? *Threw it at David and then at Jonathan.*
3. How did Jonathan get the message to David that he was in danger? *He went to the field where David was hiding. When he shot his arrow, whatever he told the boy to do, was a message for David.*
