Seven C's Beanbag Toss

Materials

Seven C's of History cards (following pages)
Masking tape
Beanbags
Optional: timer

Instructions

Keep the Seven C's of History poster displayed throughout the game for easy reference. Print and cut out two (or more) sets of cards on card stock. Place the cards face down in a grid on the floor. Use tape to mark a start line several feet from the cards. Have students line up behind the line and take turns tossing a beanbag onto the cards. Students will flip over the card the beanbag landed on, trying to find the first C—Creation. If it isn't the correct C, flip the card back over. Once Creation is found and flipped over, students will toss to find the next C—Corruption, until they get the seven C's flipped over in order. You may time the students and repeat the game, aiming for a faster time. For a large class, you may set up more than one grid or turn it into a relay with two teams tossing and racing to get their set of seven cards first.

Suggested Discussion

Today we learned how the seven C's give us the history of the Bible from creation to the consummation. The C's in the Old Testament are important to understand why Christ came to earth and died on the cross, events recorded in the New Testament. God promised a Savior in Genesis, and he was faithful to send Jesus to die for our sins and conquer Satan.

God flooded the whole world.




CONFUSION
