Review Questions

- 1. What was the place of worship God instructed the Israelites to build in the center of their camp? *The tabernacle.*
- 2. How was the tabernacle area "set apart" from the camp? A fence surrounded it.
- 3. What were animals sacrificed on in the courtyard of the tabernacle? Bronze altar.
- 4. What other item was in the courtyard so the priests could wash? Bronze basin.
- 5. What were the two rooms in the tent of meeting called? The holy place and the most holy place.
- 6. What separated the two rooms? A veil.
- 7. What item was used for light in the holy place? Golden lampstand.
- 8. What was placed on the table in the holy place every Sabbath? *Loaves* (12) of bread.
- 9. What did the showbread remind the people of? How God provided manna in the wilderness.
- 10. What was kept burning on the altar of incense? Sweet-smelling spices.
- 11. What did God tell Moses to add to furnishings including the altar of incense and the table of showbread to make them easy to carry? *Rings for poles*.
- **12.** What kind of wood was used for many of the tabernacle's furnishings: acacia, ash, or cedar? *Acacia wood.*
- 13. What special item was in the most holy place? Ark of the covenant.
- 14. What was carved over the mercy seat on the ark? Cherubim. Angels.
- 15. Who was allowed into the most holy place? The high priest.
- 16. How often did the high priest enter the most holy place? Once a year.
- 17. Who was the first high priest? Aaron.
- 18. The animals sacrificed by the priests were a picture of what final sacrifice God would send? *Jesus*.
- 19. What did God send down on the tent of meeting in the tabernacle when the people finished building everything? His cloud. His presence. His glory.
