Review Questions

- 1. What was in between the Israelites' camp and the city of Jericho? Jordan River.
- 2. Why was the Jordan River difficult to cross at this time? It was flooded, overflowing its banks.
- 3. Who did God say should lead the people and go out first from the camp? The priests.
- **4.** What were the priests commanded to carry? Ark of the covenant.
- 5. What did the priests have to do to show their faith before God worked a miracle? Put their feet in the water of the river.
- **6.** What did God do so the Israelites could cross the Jordan? Blocked the river miles away so it stopped flowing.
- 7. When the water stopped, did the people have to walk through mud or was the ground dry? The ground was dry.
- **8.** Where did Joshua set up the first 12 stones? In the middle of the river where the priests were standing with the ark.
- 9. One man from each tribe was told to collect what from the riverbed to bring to the other side? *One stone.*
- 10. What did Joshua do with the 12 stones the men collected? He stacked them up as a memorial.
- 11. In what nearby city did the people likely see the Jordan River stop and the Israelites cross? Jericho.
- **12.** What happened when the priests carried the ark out of the river to the other side? *God unblocked the river, and the water flowed like before.*
- 13. What was the name of Israel's first camp in the promised land: Jericho, Gilgal, or Kadesh? Gilgal.
- **14.** What were the Israelites supposed to remember when they saw the 12 stones? *God's miracle to stop the Jordan River so they could cross over.*
- 15. What other miracle did God do when the Israelites left Egypt that was similar to what happened at the Jordan River? He parted the Red Sea.
- 16. What is a memorial? A monument or holiday that reminds us of a person or event.
- **17. Give an example of a memorial we have today.** *Allow several students to answer. Answers may include holidays, monuments, communion, etc.*
- **18.** What does communion, or the Lord's supper, remind us of? Jesus gave his life on the cross for sinners.
- **19.** Why is it important to have memorials and to learn what they are for? To remind us of important people and events.
- **20.** Who can say the memory verse, Deuteronomy 7:9? Allow several students to recite the verse.
