

Treasure Card Match

Materials

- ☐ Game cards (following pages)
- ☐ Optional: tape or poster putty
- ☐ Optional: timer

Instructions

Print on card stock and cut out two or more sets of game cards, depending on how many students or teams are playing and how long the game should last. Lay the cards facedown. Have students take turns flipping over two cards at a time—if the cards match, keep them and take another turn. If the cards don't match, turn them back over and allow the next player to take a turn. Cards with a picture of the treasure chest count as a wild card and can be matched with any other card. When there are no more matches, have students count up the pairs of cards they collected to determine a winner.

Option 1: Divide the class into teams. Lay several sets of cards out on the floor or stick them up on the wall with tape or poster putty. Have each team work together to match pairs of cards.

Option 2: Have each student or teams of two race each other or against the clock to match pairs of cards.
