- 1. What nation conquered Judah and took the people captive: Moab, Syria, or Babylon? Babylon.
- 2. The prophet Jeremiah said the captivity in Babylon would last how long? 70 years.
- 3. What nation conquered Babylon and took over: Assyria, Egypt, or Persia? Persia.
- 4. Who was the king of Persia? Cyrus.
- 5. What proclamation, or announcement, did King Cyrus make about the Jews? That they could return to their land.
- 6. What had God commanded King Cyrus to build? A house for God; the temple.
- 7. What country were the people going to? What was their homeland called? Judah.
- 8. In what city were the people going to rebuild the temple? Jerusalem.
- 9. What special things did King Cyrus give to the Jews to take back with them? The treasures that had been stolen from the temple by the Babylonians.
- 10. What was the name of King David's descendant who led the Jewish exiles back to Jerusalem: Jehoiakim, Benjamin, or Zerubbabel? *Zerubbabel*.
- 11. Who else went with Zerubbabel back to Judah? What two groups of people? Servants and singers.
- 12. About how many people total made the journey back to Judah: 1,000; 50,000; or 100,000? 50,000.
- 13. Who organized the people to start work on rebuilding the temple? Zerubbabel.
- 14. After the builders laid the foundation for the temple, how did the priests and Levites lead the people in worship: by playing instruments, by playing a game, or by serving a meal? *Playing instruments*.
- 15. How did some of the other people living in the land feel about the Jews rebuilding the temple? They were not happy about it. They tried to keep them from rebuilding the temple.
- 16. How many years did the people have to wait before finishing the temple? 21 years.
- **17.** What did the people do when the temple was completed? They celebrated with joy—made sacrifices, sang songs, offered prayers.
- 18. What attribute of God means that he is in control over all things: love, holy, or sovereign? Sovereign.
