### Lesson 61

- 1. How many spies did Moses send into the promised land? *Twelve*.
- 2. What problems scared 10 of the spies? There were giants in the land. The cities had walls around them.
- 3. What were the names of the two spies who trusted God to help them take the land? *Joshua and Caleb.*
- 4. How did God punish the Israelites for not trusting him and going into the land? They could not enter the promised land. They had to wander in the wilderness.
- 5. Who could enter the promised land later? The young people (under 20), Joshua, and Caleb.
