## **Review Questions**

- 1. Which good king of Judah was reigning when Jeremiah was called to be a prophet? *Josiah*.
- 2. Jeremiah is sometimes called the *what* prophet because he mourned (cried) over the people's stubbornness to repent? *Weeping prophet*.
- 3. True or false: Jeremiah died before God's judgment came on Judah. False.
- 4. What punishment from God did Jeremiah warn the people of Judah about? God was sending an enemy to defeat them.
- What evil king was given the throne by King Nebuchadnezzar but rebelled and refused to serve him? Zedekiah.
- 6. What sins did Zedekiah and the people commit against the Lord? They were unfaithful; they worshipped false gods; they polluted the house of the Lord; they refused to listen to God's prophets.
- 7. What enemy did God bring against Judah? *Babylonians; King Nebuchadnezzar.*
- 8. Why did the Babylonians leave Jerusalem, making the people think they were safe? Pharaoh and his army marched against King Nebuchadnezzar.
- 9. What unpopular message did Jeremiah give when the people thought the Egyptians would save them? He said the Egyptians would return home and the Babylonians would come back and capture Jerusalem.
- 10. What did the guard at the gate in Jerusalem think Jeremiah was doing when he tried to go visit his family? He thought Jeremiah was escaping to join the Babylonians.
- 11. What did the city officials do to stop Jeremiah from speaking? *Cast him into a cistern.*
- 12. Which servant went to King Zedekiah and asked for permission to rescue Jeremiah: Ebedmelech, Evil-merodach, or Obed-edom? *Ebedmelech*.

- 13. How did Ebed-melech get Jeremiah out of the cistern? He and 30 men used rags/clothes/ropes for Jeremiah to tie around himself so they could pull him out.
- 14. What did the Babylonians do when they returned to Jerusalem? They surrounded the city and besieged it so no food/supplies/people could go in or out.
- 15. True or false: The Babylonian soldiers were merciful to old men and young women when they captured the city. False.
- 16. What did the Babylonians do to the temple (house of the Lord) in Jerusalem? They stole everything of value and burned it.
- 17. How did God protect Jeremiah when the city fell to King Nebuchadnezzar? God had Nebuchadnezzar give the command for Jeremiah to be taken care of and protected.
- 18. Who else did God save from the sword of the Babylonians because he rescued Jeremiah? *Ebed-melech*.
- 19. What happened to the people of Judah who didn't die in the fighting? The Babylonians took them as captives to Babylon (later called Persia). Some of the poorest people were left in Judah.
- 20. What did Jeremiah choose to do when Nebuchadnezzar gave him a choice to leave Judah or stay? He stayed and continued to minister for the Lord.
- 21. How did Jeremiah and Jesus both respond to the coming judgment of Jerusalem? Both lamented/wept over the fact that people would not repent and turn to God.
- 22. What attributes of God are in our memory verse, Isaiah 30:18? *Gracious, merciful (mercy), just (justice).*

Bonus: Who did King Nebuchadnezzar command to protect Jeremiah? *Nebuzaradan, the captain of the guard.*
