What You Heard *In the Word*

- God let the Israelites lose the first battle at Ai to point out Achan's sin and remind them to obey him completely.
- God helped the Israelites win the battle over five kings, making the sun stand still so they could chase after their enemies.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. How did Achan sin? *Took a cloak, gold, and silver and hid them.*
2. What happened at the battle of Ai because of Achan's sin? *The Israelites lost the battle and some men died.*
3. What did God do to help the Israelites during the battle against the five kings? *He threw hailstones at the enemy and made the sun stand still.*
