- 1. What was Israel's name before God changed it? Jacob.
- 2. Why did Israel call his sons to him before he died? He wanted to bless them.
- 3. Did Israel give blessings that would happen to his sons or to his sons' descendants, which are called tribes? *His sons' descendants, the tribes of Israel.*
- 4. Who else did Israel bless besides his 12 sons? Joseph's two sons.
- 5. Which of Israel's sons would have kings in his family line? *Judah.*
- 6. Name two symbols that were used to describe the tribe of Judah. Lion and scepter.
- 7. What kind of leaders would come from the tribe of Judah? Kings.
- 8. Which tribe of Israel did Jesus come from? Judah's tribe.
- 9. What did the fruitful bough or branch mean in Joseph's blessing? He would have many descendants.
- **10.** When Israel spoke of archers shooting at Joseph, who was he talking about? *Joseph's brothers when they tried to get rid of him.*
- 11. When Israel came down to Joseph in Egypt, about how many people were in his family? 50, 70, or 100? 70.
- 12. What did Joseph make his family promise to take with them when they returned to the land of Canaan one day? *His bones*.
- **13.** How does the book of Genesis end? With Joseph's death.
- 14. What book of the Bible comes after Genesis? Exodus.
- **15.** Over the years, the Israelites grew into a great nation. What promise does that remind us of? *God's promise to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.*
- **16. Why was it a bad thing that the new pharaoh in Egypt didn't know Joseph?** He didn't know how Joseph saved Egypt from the famine, so he didn't care about protecting Joseph's family.
