## **Review Questions**

- 1. Name one of the good things Solomon did when he first became king. (Allow several students to answer.) Asked for wisdom. Built the temple. Worshipped God. Taught the people. Wrote proverbs.
- 2. What commands did God give for the kings of Israel? (Allow several students to answer.) Not to collect horses, not to have many wives, and not to collect excessive riches (silver and gold).
- 3. How many wives did Solomon have: 500, 700, or 900? 700 wives.
- **4.** What did Solomon's foreign wives lead him to do? Worship their false gods. Turn away from following the one true God.
- 5. Why was God angry with Solomon? Solomon disobeyed God's commands.
- **6.** What punishment did God give Solomon? His kingdom would be taken away and given to his servant.
- 7. Because of David's obedience and God's promise to him, how did God show mercy? When did he say the punishment would happen? When Solomon's son became king.
- **8.** How else did God show mercy? Did he take away the entire kingdom? No. God promised to keep one tribe for his son to rule.
- 9. What was the name of Solomon's son who took over the throne after Solomon died? *Rehoboam*.
- 10. What did the people come and ask Rehoboam to do? Be nicer than Solomon was. Lighten their work load.
- **11.** How did Rehoboam answer the people? He spoke harshly and told them he'd make them work harder than his father had.
- 12. How did Rehoboam's answer make the people feel? Upset. They didn't want him as their king.
- 13. Who did the people choose to be their king instead of Rehoboam? Jeroboam, Solomon's servant.
- 14. Which tribe stayed with King Rehoboam? Judah.
- **15.** Why did King Rehoboam and his army go home instead of attacking King Jeroboam? *God told them to stop. He was in control, and they should go home.*
- 16. Who controlled all these events so that Rehoboam lost the kingdom? God.
- 17. Which attribute of God means that he is in control of everything? Sovereign.
- 18. What was the northern kingdom under Jeroboam called? Israel.
- 19. What was the southern kingdom under Rehoboam called? *Judah*.
- **20.** What can we learn about sin from the account of King Solomon? God punishes sin. God hates sin and will not stand for it. Our sin affects others.
- **21.** Who can say the memory verse? Allow several students to quote the verse.
