Review Questions

- 1. What was in between the Israelites' camp and the city of Jericho? Jordan River.
- 2. Why was the Jordan River difficult to cross during harvest time? It was flooded, overflowing its banks.
- 3. Who did God say should lead the people out from the camp? The priests.
- **4.** What were the priests commanded to carry? *Ark of the covenant.*
- 5. What did the priests have to do to show their faith before God worked a miracle? Put their feet in the water of the river.
- **6.** What did God do to allow the Israelites to cross the Jordan? *Blocked the river miles away so it stopped flowing.*
- 7. Where did Joshua set up the first 12 stones? In the middle of the river where the priests were standing with the ark
- 8. Who collected 12 stones from the riverbed and brought them to the other side? *Men (leaders) from each of the 12 tribes of Israel.*
- 9. In what nearby city did the people likely see the Jordan River stop and the Israelites cross? Jericho.
- **10.** What happened when the priests carried the ark out of the river to the other side? *God unblocked the river, and it returned to its place.*
- 11. What was the name of Israel's first camp in the promised land: Jericho, Gilgal, or Kadesh? Gilgal.
- 12. What did Joshua do with the 12 stones the leaders brought to Gilgal? He set them up as a memorial.
- **13.** What were the Israelites supposed to remember when they saw the 12 stones? *God's miracle to stop the Jordan River so they could cross over.*
- 14. What other miracle did God do through Moses that was similar to what happened at the Jordan River? He parted the Red Sea.
- **15.** What is the purpose of a memorial? Honor the memory of a person or event.
- **16. Give an example of a memorial we have today.** Allow several students to answer. Answers may include holidays, monuments, Lord's supper, etc.
- **17.** Why is it important to have memorials and to learn what they are for? To keep us from forgetting important people and events.
- **18.** Who can say the memory verse, Deuteronomy 7:9? Allow several students to recite the verse.

Bonus: What was inside the ark of the covenant? Tablets of stone with the Ten Commandments.
