1. What word did we learn that means to purposely disobey authority? *Rebel.*
2. Name one of the three men who rebelled against God and Moses. *Allow several students to answer. Korah, Dathan, Abiram.*
3. What did the 250 leaders want to be? It was a special job. *Priests.*
4. Who did God choose to be priests? *Aaron and his sons.*
5. Why were the men rebelling? How did they feel about Moses and Aaron? *They were jealous.*
6. How did Moses warn the people so they would not be punished along with the three rebellious men? *He told them to move away from their tents/dwellings.*
7. What supernatural punishment did God send on Korah, Dathan, and Abiram? *The ground opened up and swallowed them. An earthquake.*
8. What happened to the 250 leaders who were offering incense? *Fire from the Lord destroyed them.*
9. How did Moses disobey when God brought water from the rock? *Moses struck the rock instead of speaking to it. He and Aaron took credit for the miracle.*
10. How did God punish Moses and Aaron for disobeying his instructions about the rock? *They would not enter the promised land.*
11. When the Israelites got impatient and complained to Moses about food and water, what punishment did God send throughout the camp? *Fiery serpents.*
12. What happened to people who were bitten by the snakes God sent? *They died.*
13. When the Israelites asked Moses to pray for them because of the snakes, how did God show mercy? *He had Moses make a bronze serpent that the people could look at and be healed.*
14. Who actually healed the people from the snakebites when they looked at the bronze serpent—Moses, God, or the bronze serpent? *God.*
15. Who was the bronze serpent a picture of? *Jesus on the cross.*
16. How was Jesus like the bronze serpent? *Jesus saves people from eternal death just as the bronze serpent saved people from physical death.*
17. What is the reference of our memory verse? *Deuteronomy 7:9.*
18. Based on the memory verse, what two things does God keep for those who love him and keep his commandments? *Covenant and steadfast love.*
