

Stack the Stones

Materials

- ☐ Large or jumbo marshmallows
- ☐ Frosting
- ☐ Plastic knives
- ☐ Paper plates

Instructions

Give each student a plastic knife and 12 marshmallows. Have them spread frosting on the ends or sides of the marshmallows as they stack them up. When the stacks are finished you may want to allow students to eat a few marshmallows from their stack for a snack while you move on to the Suggested Discussion.

Suggested Discussion

Today, we stacked up marshmallows to help us remember our lesson.

- ?** But what did Joshua stack to remember what God did for the Israelites at the Jordan River? *Stones.*
- ?** Right. What did God do for them? *Allow discussion. Stopped the river from flowing so they could cross on dry ground.*

God told Joshua to stack the stones so when the Israelites' children saw them, they could ask what the stones meant. Then the Israelites could tell them about the powerful, amazing God they served.
