Review Questions

Lesson 51

- 1. Why did Pharaoh want all the Israelite baby boys killed? He was afraid they would grow up to be soldiers and take over.
- 2. How did Pharaoh's daughter feel when she saw baby Moses crying? She felt sorry for him and wanted to adopt him.
- 3. When Moses was adopted by the princess, what did he become? *A prince*.
- 4. Moses knew he was an Egyptian or an Israelite? *An Israelite*.
- 5. What did Moses do to the Egyptian who was beating an Israelite slave? He killed him and hid the body in the sand.
- 6. Why did Moses have to flee to Midian?

 Pharaoh found out about him killing the Egyptian and wanted to kill him.

Lesson 52

- 7. What did God tell Moses to remove when he came near the burning bush? *His sandals*.
- 8. Why was Moses supposed to remove his sandals? He was on holy ground.
- 9. At the burning bush, what task did God give to Moses? To lead the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt.
- 10. What attributes of God do we learn from the name I AM? Eternal, independent, and immutable.
- 11. Name one of the three signs God gave Moses to show the Israelites. Allow several students to answer. Staff turned into a serpent (snake), hand covered with leprosy and then restored, and water turned into blood.

- 12. What did God command Pharaoh to do through Moses and Aaron? Let the Israelites go.
- 13. What happened when Aaron's staff and the magicians' staffs turned into snakes? Aaron's snake ate the others.

- 14. What did God want the Egyptians to learn about him through the plagues? That he is the one true God.
- 15. How did God show mercy to the Egyptians before the plague of hail? He sent Moses to warn them that it was coming so they could bring their people and animals inside.
- **16.** How did Pharaoh show that he had a hard heart toward God? He kept refusing to obey God's command to let the Israelites go.

- **17.** What was the tenth plague? *Death of the firstborn.*
- 18. How did God tell the Israelites to protect themselves from the tenth plague? Sacrifice a lamb and spread its blood on the doorposts.
- 19. During the tenth plague, the Israelites were instructed to stay in their homes and eat a special meal called what? *Passover.*
- 20. What time of day did God strike the Egyptians with the tenth plague: sunrise, twilight, or midnight? *Midnight*.
- 21. What did Pharaoh do after he lost his firstborn son? He said the Israelites could go.
- **22.** Why is Jesus called the Lamb of God? He is the perfect sacrifice whose blood takes away our sins and saves us from eternal death.

- **28.** What happened when Pharaoh and his army followed the Israelites into the sea? God caused the sea to return to its usual place, drowning the Egyptians.
