

# Review Questions

## Lesson 51

1. Why did Pharaoh want all the Israelite baby boys killed? *He was afraid they would grow up to be soldiers and take over.*
2. How did Pharaoh's daughter feel when she saw baby Moses crying? *She felt sorry for him and wanted to adopt him.*
3. When Moses was adopted by the princess, what did he become? *A prince.*
4. Moses knew he was an Egyptian or an Israelite? *An Israelite.*
5. What did Moses do to the Egyptian who was beating an Israelite slave? *He killed him and hid the body in the sand.*
6. Why did Moses have to flee to Midian? *Pharaoh found out about him killing the Egyptian and wanted to kill him.*

## Lesson 52

7. What did God tell Moses to remove when he came near the burning bush? *His sandals.*
8. Why was Moses supposed to remove his sandals? *He was on holy ground.*
9. At the burning bush, what task did God give to Moses? *To lead the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt.*
10. What attributes of God do we learn from the name I AM? *Eternal, independent, and immutable.*
11. Name one of the three signs God gave Moses to show the Israelites. *Allow several students to answer. Staff turned into a serpent (snake), hand covered with leprosy and then restored, and water turned into blood.*

12. What did God command Pharaoh to do through Moses and Aaron? *Let the Israelites go.*
13. What happened when Aaron's staff and the magicians' staffs turned into snakes? *Aaron's snake ate the others.*

14. What did God want the Egyptians to learn about him through the plagues? *That he is the one true God.*
15. How did God show mercy to the Egyptians before the plague of hail? *He sent Moses to warn them that it was coming so they could bring their people and animals inside.*
16. How did Pharaoh show that he had a hard heart toward God? *He kept refusing to obey God's command to let the Israelites go.*

## Lesson 54

17. What was the tenth plague? *Death of the firstborn.*
18. How did God tell the Israelites to protect themselves from the tenth plague? *Sacrifice a lamb and spread its blood on the doorposts.*
19. During the tenth plague, the Israelites were instructed to stay in their homes and eat a special meal called what? *Passover.*
20. What time of day did God strike the Egyptians with the tenth plague: sunrise, twilight, or midnight? *Midnight.*
21. What did Pharaoh do after he lost his firstborn son? *He said the Israelites could go.*
22. Why is Jesus called the Lamb of God? *He is the perfect sacrifice whose blood takes away our sins and saves us from eternal death.*

23. How did God keep his promise to give the people "great possessions" when they left Egypt? *The Israelites asked the Egyptians for their jewelry and clothing, and the Egyptians gave it to them.*
24. How did God lead the Israelites on their journey? *By a pillar of cloud and fire.*
25. What did Pharaoh and the Egyptians decide to do after the Israelites had left? *Chase after the Israelites and bring them back.*
26. Where did the Israelites get trapped? *At the Red Sea.*

27. How did God miraculously provide a way of escape for the Israelites? *He parted the Red Sea so they could cross on dry ground.*

28. What happened when Pharaoh and his army followed the Israelites into the sea? *God caused the sea to return to its usual place, drowning the Egyptians.*

29. What did the Israelites complain about to Moses and Aaron, saying they had it back in Egypt? *They wanted meat and bread.*

30. What did God provide for meat in the evening? *Quail.*

31. What does the word *manna* mean? It's a question. *What is it?*

32. What was one way God provided water through Moses? *Moses threw a log into the water and turned it sweet. Moses struck a rock with his staff and water poured out.*

33. When did God give the Israelites victory in their battle against the Amalekites? What did Moses have to do? *Moses had to keep his staff/hands raised.*

34. What do we call the commands God gave Moses and the Israelites at Mount Sinai? *The Ten Commandments.*

35. What does it mean to put God first in our lives? *Nothing should be more important to us than God.*

36. What does it mean to not use the Lord's name in vain? *Don't use God's name as a swear word. Honor God with your words.*

37. What is the fifth commandment? It has to do with obeying. *Honor your father and your mother.*

38. What does covet mean? *To want what others have.*

39. Why did God give the Ten Commandments? What do they show us? *Our sin and need for Jesus.*

40. What did the Israelites want Aaron to make for them when Moses hadn't come down from Mount Sinai? *False gods, idol.*

41. What did the idol that Aaron made look like? *A golden calf.*

42. Why was it a sin for the Israelites to make and worship the golden calf? *They were breaking the first two commandments God gave them.*

43. What did Moses do when God was going to destroy the Israelites for their sin? *He prayed and asked God to show mercy.*

44. What did Moses do when he came down the mountain and saw the people worshipping the golden calf? *He broke the stone tablets with the Ten Commandments. He burned the golden calf, ground it into powder, and made the people drink it.*

45. What punishment did God send because of the Israelites' idolatry? *A plague.*

46. What was the place of worship God instructed the Israelites to build in the center of their camp? *The tabernacle.*

47. What were the two rooms in the tent of meeting called? *The holy place and the most holy place.*

48. What special item was in the most holy place? *Ark of the covenant.*

49. Who was allowed into the most holy place only once a year? *The high priest.*

50. The animals sacrificed by the priests were a picture of what final sacrifice God would send? *Jesus.*
