Review Questions

- 1. What book of the Bible did we study today? Exodus.
- 2. What did God command Pharaoh to do through Moses and Aaron? Let the Israelites (his people) go.
- 3. Pharaoh said the Israelites were lazy and commanded that they collect their own what to make bricks? *Straw.*
- **4.** What happened when Aaron's staff and the magician's staffs turned into snakes? *Aaron's snake ate the others.*
- 5. Are the plagues God sent in Egypt a sickness or a severe judgment? A severe judgment from God.
- 6. What did God want the Egyptians to learn about him through the plagues? That he is the one true God.
- 7. What was the first plague? Water turned to blood.
- 8. What happened after God killed all the frogs he brought up from the river in the second plague? The people gathered the dead frogs in piles and the land stank.
- 9. What was the first plague that the magicians couldn't copy: frogs, gnats, or darkness? *The third plague of gnats.*
- 10. During which plague did God start protecting the Israelites: the first (water into blood), fourth (flies), or sixth (boils)? The fourth plague of flies.
- 11. Which plague on the Egyptians made them unclean? The sixth plague of boils.
- **12.** How did God show mercy to the Egyptians before the plague of hail? He sent Moses to warn them that it was coming so they could bring their people and animals inside.
- 13. What plague led to all the remaining food being eaten after the hailstorm? The eighth plague of locusts.
- 14. What plague showed that God was more powerful than the sun god, Ra? The ninth plague of darkness.
- **15.** How did Pharaoh show that he had a hard heart toward God? He kept refusing to obey God's command to let the Israelites go. He clung to his false gods.
- 16. What attribute describes God as all-powerful? Omnipotent.
- 17. According to our memory verse, what should we not do because God is with us? Fear.
- **18. Who would like to try saying the memory verse?** Allow several students to try reciting the verse.
