Review Questions

- **1.** What good things did Solomon do early in his reign as king? Asked for wisdom. Built the temple. Worshipped God. Taught the people.
- **2.** Name one of the books of the Bible that Solomon wrote. (Allow several students to answer.) Proverbs. *Ecclesiastes. Song of Solomon.*
- **3.** What commands did God give for the kings of Israel? (Allow several students to answer.) Not to collect horses (from Egypt), not to have many wives, and not to collect excessive silver and gold (wealth).
- 4. How many wives did Solomon have: 500, 700, or 900? 700 wives.
- **5.** What did Solomon's foreign wives lead him to do? Worship their false gods. Turn away from following the one true God.
- 6. Why was God angry with Solomon? Solomon disobeyed God's commands.
- 7. What punishment did God give Solomon? His kingdom would be taken away and given to his servant.
- **8.** How did God show mercy when he gave Solomon this punishment? The kingdom would be torn away from his son instead of from Solomon. God promised to keep one tribe for his son to rule.
- **9.** Why did God show mercy to Solomon? For whose sake? Because of the obedience of David and God's promise to him, God extended mercy to Solomon.
- 10. What was the name of Solomon's son who took over the throne after Solomon died? *Rehoboam*.
- 11. What did the people come and ask Rehoboam to do? Be nicer than Solomon was. Lighten their work load.
- **12.** How did Rehoboam answer the people? He spoke harshly and told them he'd make them work harder than his father had.
- **13.** How did Rehoboam's answer make the people feel? Upset. They didn't want him as their king.
- 14. Who did the people choose to be their king instead of Rehoboam? Jeroboam, Solomon's servant.
- 15. Which tribe stayed loyal to King Rehoboam, the descendant of David? *Judah.*
- 16. Why did King Rehoboam stop gathering an army to fight King Jeroboam? God told him to.
- 17. Who controlled events so that Rehoboam lost the kingdom? God.
- 18. Which attribute of God means that he is in control of everything? Sovereign.
- 19. What was the northern kingdom under Jeroboam called? Israel.
- 20. What was the smaller southern kingdom under Rehoboam called? Judah.
- **21.** What can we learn about sin from the account of King Solomon? *God punishes sin. God hates sin and will not stand for it. Sin affects others.*
- **22.** Who can say the memory verse? Allow several students to quote the verse.
