## **Review Questions**

- 1. Who can remember an interesting fact about ancient Egypt? (Allow several students to answer.) Pyramids were built as tombs for pharaohs; Egyptians invented scripts (hieroglyphics); Egyptians wore makeup; Cats were sacred; Egyptians used papyrus paper, pens, locks, keys, and toothpaste; Egyptians had more than 2,000 false gods.
- 2. Who bought Joseph as a slave in Egypt? Potiphar.
- 3. What position did Potiphar give Joseph? Overseer.
- **4.** What does an overseer do? Directs the work of other people to get a job done.
- **5.** How did God bless Joseph as a slave? Gave him favor with Potiphar and a good position. Blessed everything he did.
- 6. What did Joseph do when Potiphar's wife tried to get him to sin? He fled.
- 7. How did Potiphar's wife feel when Joseph ran away from her? *Angry!*
- **8.** What did she do to get back at Joseph? She lied and said that he attacked her.
- 9. How did Potiphar punish Joseph because of his wife's lies? Threw him in prison.
- 10. How do you think Joseph felt when he was first thrown in prison? Disappointed, sad, discouraged.
- **11.** How did God bless Joseph in prison? Gave him favor with the keeper of the prison (jailer), who put Joseph in charge of the prisoners.
- **12.** What two important officials of Pharaoh were put under Joseph's care in prison? *Chief cupbearer and baker.*
- 13. Who told the cupbearer and the baker the meaning of their dreams? *Joseph.*
- 14. At Pharaoh's birthday feast, who was given his job back? Cupbearer.
- 15. Who did Pharaoh put to death? Baker.
- 16. Who did Joseph ask to help get him out of prison? Cupbearer.
- 17. What happened when the cupbearer got his job back? Did he remember or forget about Joseph? He forgot about him.
- 18. Who was in control of everything that happened to Joseph? God.
- 19. What is the reference of our new memory verse? Romans 8:28.
