What You Heard *In the Word*

The people disobeyed God's command to fill the earth. God punished sin by changing the people's language, causing them to scatter over the earth.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What did the people decide to do instead of spreading out and filling the earth? *Stay there and build a tower and a city.*
2. What did God do to the people's language to punish their sin? *Confused it. Made them speak different languages.*
3. What happened when God confused the language? *People couldn't understand each other so they moved away.*

Justin & Jessie

A smaller boy stopped them. He said something to Justin, but they couldn't understand him at all. Justin shook his head and tried to move past the boy, but the boy put up his hands to block Justin. "I think he's speaking a different language," said Jessie.



What will Justin do? In "I Don't Understand," Justin learns that just because a person speaks in a different language doesn't mean what they're saying isn't important.
