1. What was the place of worship God instructed the Israelites to build in the center of their camp? *The tabernacle.*
2. How was the tabernacle area “set apart” from the camp? What surrounded it? *A fence.*
3. What were animals sacrificed on in the courtyard of the tabernacle? *Bronze altar.*
4. What other item was in the courtyard so the priests could wash? *Bronze basin.*
5. What were the two rooms in the tent of meeting called? *The holy place and the most holy place.*
6. What separated the two rooms? *A veil.*
7. What item was used for light in the holy place? *Golden lampstand.*
8. What was placed on the table in the holy place every Sabbath? *Twelve loaves of bread. Showbread.*
9. What did the showbread remind the people of? *How God provided manna in the wilderness.*
10. What was kept burning on the altar of incense? *Sweet-smelling spices.*
11. What did God tell Moses to add to furnishings including the altar of incense and the table of showbread to make them easy to carry? *Rings for poles.*
12. What special item was in the most holy place? *Ark of the covenant.*
13. What was carved over the mercy seat on the ark of the covenant? *Cherubim. Angels.*
14. Who was allowed into the most holy place? *The high priest.*
15. How often did the high priest enter the most holy place? *Once a year.*
16. Who was the first high priest? *Aaron.*
17. The animal sacrifices were a picture of someone. Who was that? *Jesus.*
18. Animal sacrifices were made over and over, but how many times was Jesus sacrificed for our sins? *Just once.*
19. What did God send down on the tent of meeting in the tabernacle when the people finished building everything he commanded them to build? *His cloud. His presence. His glory.*
20. Who can say the memory verse? *Allow several students to try reciting the verse.*
