K-1st Review Questions

- 1. What is an eyewitness: someone who sees something happen, someone who hears about something, or someone who reads about something? Someone who sees something happen.
- 2. Can you name someone who was an eyewitness of Jesus' life? *John; Peter; 12 disciples.*
- 3. What did John say about his testimony—the things he wrote about Jesus: it might be wrong, it was true, or he made up part of it? It was true.
- 4. Who did John say Jesus was? The Christ, the Son of God.
- 5. Why did John say he wrote about Jesus? What did he want people to do? *Believe in Jesus*.
- 6. Those who believe in Christ will have what in his name? *Life (eternal life)*.
