## *Lesson Focus*

---

God created the Passover to protect the Israelites from the final plague and to remind them of his power. The death of the firstborn sons and livestock of Egypt showed that God was more powerful than Pharaoh, who finally said the Israelites could go. The Passover foreshadowed Jesus as the spotless Lamb whose blood saves us from our sins.

## *What You Heard in the Word*
