## **Promise Craft Sheet**

## **Materials**

Promise craft sheets (following page)
Gold glitter
Brown or yellow yarn or raffia cut into small pieces (1 inch)
Crayons
Glue
Plastic/paper bowls or plates for glue
Cotton swabs
Scissors

## **Instructions**


Print one copy of the craft sheet for each student. Pour glue into plastic/paper bowls or plates for students to share. Set out cotton swabs for applying glue.

Have students color the pictures on their sheets. Use cotton swabs to apply glue to the crown and the roof and pillars of the temple then sprinkle gold glitter on those sections. Next, have students apply glue and add small pieces of yarn or raffia to the hay in and around the manger.
