What You Heard *In the Word*

- Nehemiah prayed for God's strength to help him against the traps and threats of his enemies.
- Nehemiah was a good leader. He helped the people with physical needs, such as food and housing. He also helped them with spiritual needs by gathering them to hear a reading of God's laws.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. When Nehemiah's enemies tried to keep him from building the wall, who did Nehemiah turn to? *God.*
2. How did Nehemiah help the poor people who were being treated badly by the Jewish officials? *He told the officials they had to stop, and the people got their land and homes back.*
3. Who did Nehemiah ask to read the Book of the Law to the people? *Ezra.*
